You will be willing to positively share your own life experiences, including experience of mental ill health, to form effective, supportive and enabling peer relationships that assist service users in raising aspirations and developing personal goals. You will work independently as well as part of a team. Education to GCSE or NVQ 3 standard is required, knowledge acquired through experience will also be considered. You must be willing to undertake Peer Support Worker training OR have completed related training.

Although based with a specific team some travel around the locality will be required.
